Detailed planning conditions and a need to preserve the original oak beams meant the rooflights needed to work within the existing roof structure. Our team worked closely with the architects to create a design that worked with the line of the oak beams. Linking bars create a run of natural light that results in a stunning internal finish. Externally, the low-profile frame of The Conservation Rooflights seamlessly integrated with the original building, enhancing its architectural integrity while fully complying with the precise planning regulations.
